As a premier college success and youth leadership development program, Posse seeks out high caliber students who could excel at highly selective colleges but may be missed by traditional recruitment criteria. Posse offers an eight-month pre-collegiate training program, provides support through all four years of college, and helps students secure competitive internships, leadership-track jobs, and graduate school placements. Providence College, and other Posse partner colleges across the U.S., provide full-tuition scholarships, faculty mentoring, and additional support, such as counseling, training, and group programming.

INSTITUTIONAL IMPACT

The concept of a posse is rooted in the belief that a small, diverse group of talented students, carefully selected and trained, can serve as a catalyst for increased individual and community development. PC's collaboration with Posse will help us recruit students from diverse backgrounds, build a more inclusive and interactive campus environment, and ensure that PC is a welcoming place for all.


